Powered Hand Tool Safety

- Know Your Equipment Avoid using any tool until you've been trained to use it properly.
- Work Habits Avoid being struck by debris by keeping yourself and others out of its path.
- **Inspect Your Tools** Always check out the tool and its power supply before you begin any job.
- Defend Yourself Check nearby and your work area to make sure it is safe for you and those around you to proceed.
- Power Cords Get the right type and length of extension cord for the job. Use a ground fault circuit interrupter or GFCI. Keep cord away from equipment path.
